

We have an issue with a new Windows 7 pc in an activedirectory domain. There was no user to do the job for us to allow rdp-sessions. We have cmd access (psexec) and find a handy command to enable rdp session from the command line.

Give the command:

```
reg add "HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINESYSTEMCurrentControlSetControlTerminal Server" /v  
fDenyTSConnections /t REG_DWORD /d 0 /f
```

Rdp should working now, without a reboot.
