O my god, what is wrong, It's just monday!

The Notificatoin:

ePolicy Orchestrator Notification

Response Name: Distributed Repository Replication failed Event Type Name: Server

Description: Sends an e-mail notification when "Distributed Repository Replication failed" events are received.

On the Epo server the error was more detailed. (Server logs)

## **Solution:**

- On the Epo-server Rename the file catalog.z to (for example) catalog.z.old in X:\MCAFEePolicy OrchestratorDBSoftware

- Start on the Epo-Server the "Master Repository Update " task, wait to end succesfully
- Start on the Epo-Server the "Repository Replication" task.

I hope this is the solution for you also. I don't no the cause, maybe a fallen bit.
