One of my users mentioned about missing nationalholidays in his Outlook Calendar. I followed the <u>procedure</u> to add these days to my calendar and saw that the holidays where added. The difference, I use Outlook 2007, the user Outlook 2003. For Outlook 2007, first install <a href="https://hotfix.kb2687329">hotfix kb2687329</a>

My solution is to pick the holidays out of the OUTLOOK.HOL file from my Office 2007 installation and put these days in de OUTLOOK.HOL file on the Office 2003 machine. This solution worked.

On Windows 7/Office 2007 the file is located in: C:Program Files (x86)Microsoft OfficeOffice121043

On Windows XP/Offcice 2003 the file is located in: C:Program FilesMicrosoft OfficeOffice111043

The office installation is in Dutch, so probaly your OUTLOOK.HOL is on another location
