
Na installatie van SP1 op Windows 2008 R2, uitgekomen 22-02-2011, ging ik e.e.a. testen op de server of alles naar behoren werkte, nog niet dus. Of het door de installatie van SP1 is gekomen of dat dit probleem er al eerder inzat - n.a.v. van powershell scripten - kan ik niet achterhalen. Maar het kan altijd, vandaar hier het relaas:

De oplossing voor deze fout was niet "winrm quickconfig" , maar het toevoegen van een "http 80 **" binding aan de Default Web Site in de IIS Manager.

De fout was nog niet opgelost maar wel anders geworden, op de goede weg dus. De volgende foutmelding verscheen:

Deze melding komt duidelijker over. De Powershell console gestart:

[PS] C:\Get-ExecutionPolicy
Restricted

Inderdaad, powershell scripts is gedisabled. Deze maar beperkt openzetten:
